ITINERARY

ONCE THE GROUP GOING IS CONFIRMED

– we will plan our itinerary from the following possibilities:

In Phnom Penh

- Volunteer for a morning at Les Restaurants des Enfants – feeding & supporting education of street children
- Visit DomlaiMon - social sewing enterprise supporting families living with HIV
- Tuol Sleng S21 Genocide Museum & The Killing Fields
- Eat at Daughters of Cambodia – helping women leave the sex trade
- Other optional extras - Russian Market, Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda – according to interest and time available.

In Siem Reap

- Volunteer at New Hope Cambodia School – teaching English to primary age students &/or young adults
- Visit Feeding Dreams Cambodia school, lunch at the Hospitality Training Centre, help in some way
- Fund / help Build a house for a needy family
- Fund / Help Build toilet(s)
- Fund water wells and water filters to provide clean water to a group of families that need it. Visit the site, meet the families, but employ some locals to do the actual building.
- Visit another poor region in Siem Reap that we visited the last two years. Continue the conversation with Sopheak and El to scope how we can continue to help these families in a meaningful and sustainable way.
- Visit Rehash Trash recycling project. Do a craft class, making something out of rubbish!
- Other possible sight seeing in and around Siem Reap depending on interest and time available:
 - Visit to Angkor Wat and other Temples of Angkor – many ways we can do this.
 - Visit to Kulen Mountain and waterfall, 50kms into the countryside by bus
 - Floating Village on Tonle Sap Lake
 - Phare Circus – it's amazing!!
 - Made in Cambodia handmade market – all locally made
 - Opportunities for more active day trips – walking, cycling, overnight camping
 - Eat a favourite cafes and restaurants that showcase authentic and creative Khmer food – some are also training restaurants
 - Cooking class
 - Support local businesses – markets, massage, manicures, gelati, recycled home wares, locally made clothes

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT WITH ROTARY CLUB OF TAILEM BEND.

Please read carefully the terms in the conditions of contract in completing and submitting the Booking Form, you agree to be bound by these conditions, which constitute the agreement between the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend and you. The conditions apply to the exclusion of any other terms or conditions unless they are set out in the Booking Form or are otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. No purported variation of these conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by a person so authorised by the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend.

1. **How to Book:** To participate in the Volunteers Trip to Cambodia, you must contact volunteer@tailembendrotary.com.au
2. **Cancellations and Transfers:** If you wish to cancel your tour, you must notify the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend and you will lose the cost of the flights that have already been paid for. (Travel insurance may compensate you depending on the circumstances.)
Once booked, if you need to change any dates of travel, please notify us and then negotiate that yourself with our contact at the Murray Bridge Flight Centre.
3. **Travel and Fitness Requirements:** We recommend that participants are healthy and active. If however, you have pre-existing medical conditions you are required to have a medical form completed by your doctor.
4. **Route Changes, Postponement, Cancellation or Delay**
The Rotary Club of Tailem Bend reserves the right to:
 - a) Modify any aspect of the tour, or
 - b) Cancel or modify any routes within the tour or objectives set out in the itinerary, or
 - c) Substitute different or equivalent routes within the tour in place of cancelled or modified routes, or
 - d) Postpone, cancel or delay (either in relation to the departure or arrival times or the duration of the tour) any such aspect of the tour if, in the absolute discretion of the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend, it is necessary to do so due to inclement weather or conditions that are otherwise likely to be hazardous or dangerous or due to any other adverse or threatening conditions whether political or military or terrorist or otherwise or if, in the absolute discretion of the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend there is a likelihood of any such event occurring which may impact upon the safety of the participants, or if an act or omission of a third party prevents the tour or the aspect of the tour being undertaken in accordance with your booking. In the event of any change, modification, cancellation postponement or delay under this condition, you acknowledge that you will have no right of refund of the tour price (whether in whole or in part) and no right to claim compensation for any injury, loss or damage or other additional expenses incurred by virtue of the change, modification, cancellation postponement or delay. Travel insurance may compensate you depending on the circumstances.
5. **Insurance:** *Rotary travel insurance is included in the tour price.* You should review the policy carefully to decide whether it is appropriate for you. You may wish to purchase your own travel insurance.
6. **Airline:** The tour cost includes international fares. These terms and 'Conditions of Contract' are not issued on behalf of, and do not commit, any associated airlines whose services are used or proposed to be used in the course of the tour.
7. **Package Prices:** Travel costs are based on ground costs, airfares and exchange rates at the date of initial promotion of this trip. While we try our utmost not to increase our prices, sometimes it is outside our control. We reserve the right to amend our prices without notice, at any time up to and including the day of departure of any trip, in the event of exchange rate fluctuations, or any other cost that is outside of our control.
8. **Visas and Passports:** You must have a valid passport, which has at least six months validity beyond your return date. We will send you a link to the OFFICIAL eVISA WEBSITE to each purchase online about a month before we go. They only last for 3 months, so we cannot do these too early.
9. **Police Checks:** These will be needed for all those volunteering in at New Hope Cambodia. If you don't already have one, we will give you instructions for doing this in such a way that it will not incur too much cost.
5. **Health Statements:** For insurance purposes, you will need to visit your Doctor with a copy of our Health Statement to sign before you travel. This is also a good time to discuss immunisation with your Doctor.
